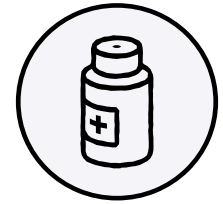


COVID-19 Vaccine: Initial roll-out



Getting vaccinated

What to expect for MIQ and border workers: Phase 1

- If you are a border or MIQ worker in Auckland you will either get an email or a text from your DHB inviting you to be vaccinated
- Please talk with your employer before confirming your appointment so that they can ensure there is cover available for you whilst you are being vaccinated
- If you are not able to make that appointment, follow the instructions that were on your booking form
- When you receive your appointment, you will be sent a link to an online form that you can use to provide the details of the people you live with who will also be offered the vaccine
- Their details will be added to the COVID-19 Immunisation Register and they will be contacted at a later date to be vaccinated
- Please seek their permission before you share their details
- If you are unable to access the online form, you can call 0800 282 926
- When you arrive for your appointment, the health professional will talk you through the process ahead of receiving the vaccine
- You will be asked to provide consent to receive the vaccine. This is standard procedure for any vaccination
- You will also be asked for your permission to notify your employer that you have received the vaccine
- Because of the critical role you play standing between New Zealand communities and COVID-19, it helps if your employer has full visibility of all the protection measures available to you in your role
- After you have received the vaccine you will be asked to stay for half an hour to make sure you don't suffer any adverse effects like an allergic reaction
- Before you leave you will be given a record card with the date you've been immunised and the batch number along with more information on side effects
- You will be sent an automated reminder to receive the second dose 3 weeks later
